Willard M. Masticke to Orrin Dayton...also in Burton

This Indenture was made this 23 day of April 1825 by and between Orrin Dayton of the first part and Mill and Moon Masticke to a minor under the age of twenty one years to wit of the age of sixteen years of the second part both of Burton in the County of Geauga and State of Ohio witnesseth that the said party of the second part doth by these presents voluntarily, of his own free will and accord and with the consent of Jonathan Brooks and Peter Hitchcock his legal guardians put himself an apprentice to the party of the first part to learn the art and mistery of farming and with him after the manner of an apprentice to serve from the date of this implement until he is of the age of twenty one years which will be on the 26th day of February AD 1830 during which time the said apprentice his said master faithfully shall serve and obey all his lawful commands and in all things shall as a faithful apprentice behave himself towards his said master during the said term. And the said party of the first part doth hereby covenant and agree to with the said party of the second part that he will during the term of aforesaid furnish the said party of the second part with necessary meat, drink, apparel, lodging, clothing and medicine that he will take care of him in sickness and in health that he will instruct him in the art and mistery of farming, that he will send him to school for and during the term of seven months that he may be instructed to read, write, and so much arithmetic as to include the single rule of three and at the end of said term that he will furnish said apprentice with two suits of common wearing apparel, (sic) or cloths (sic) equal there unto with a new bible and will also pay him seventy five dollars in neat cattle. In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our hands and seals this 23rd day of April 1825.
