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In view of the existing line, and the small tract of land were agreed to be considered as being unoccupied.

On examining witness I became fully satisfied that the original N.W. corner of land now owned by H. S. Well was situated at the N. margin of the State Road 1399 about from the western boundary line of C.P. Chapin's lands. At that place I caused another corner to be placed as near the old one as possible. The place was pointed out to me by W. H. Beals and I having chained it previously and found it agreed exactly with the line called for in the deed. I was fully satisfied it was where the old corner stood.
