Commenced on and this 21<sup>st</sup> day of September 1861. in accordance with Order of the Board of Surveyors.

Survey of a survey of part of lot 13 in Town of Smith's  
Orange Co. The survey was made by request of E. F. Wood  
Esq for the purpose of establishing carefully the N. W. corner  
and western boundary line of land now owned and occupied  
by the said E. F. Wood. On examining the same I became  
fully satisfied that the original N. W. corner of land now owned  
by E. F. Wood was situated on the N. margin of the State Road  
1299 ch. westerly from the western boundary line of C. B. Chap-  
man's land. It had pleased the said E. F. Wood another corner to be  
placed as near the old one as possible. The place was pointed  
out to me by W. H. Beals and being chained it precisely  
and found it agreed exactly with the line called for in the  
deed. I was fully satisfied it was where the old corner stood  
In running the western boundary line of said 82 acres I  
found it necessary to vary the point of compass 10 45' from  
that called for in the deed. In running the line I hit  
and run very near old marked trees indicating the old orig-  
inal line. In placing the N. W. corner stones of said 82 acres the following persons were present  
viz. W. H. Beals, E. H. Heath, Hester Burroughs, Stephen Carsons, William and Chas. Wood  
Wm. E. Lonsom, Randall Pratt and A. C. Elsworth. E. F. Wood Marked. In witness  
whereof a survey was made Sept 21<sup>st</sup> A. D. 1861 by Seth Adams County Surveyor  
and for surveying plotting & recording \$450.  
Received E. F. Wood \$50. and Recorded October 1<sup>st</sup> 1861 in accordance with C. Ludlow Receiver.
