

Copy of Petition and proceedings for the enlargement of corporate limits of the Incorporated Village of Chardon in the County of Geauga and State of Ohio

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of Geauga County in the State of Ohio

The Incorporated Village of Chardon in said County by its legally constituted Authorities Respectfully represents that on the 21st day of December A.D. 1870 an Ordinance was duly and legally passed by the Council of said Incorporated Village to enlarge the Corporate limits thereof by the Annexation of Contiguous Territory of which Ordinance the following is a Copy. An Ordinance. To authorize the enlargement of the Corporate limits of the Incorporated Village of Chardon in the County of Geauga and State of Ohio by the annexation of contiguous territory. Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Village of Chardon

Sec 1st That the Corporate limits of said Incorporated Village of Chardon be and the same are hereby authorized to be extended on the north, west and south sides of the existing bounds of said Village by adding and annexing thereto the lands contiguous and adjoining the same on said north, west and south sides and circumscribed within the following boundaries Beginning at the north east corner of lot 140 being the north east corner of said Corporate limits as heretofore established: thence running north along the east line of lot No 134 being the Township line to the north east corner of said lot No 134 thence west along the north line of lots No 134, 132, 130 and 129 to the northwest corner of said lot No 129 thence south along the west line of lots No 129, 135, 136, 137, 138 and 139 to the south west corner of said lot No 139 being the south line of said Township thence east along said Township line being the south line of lots No 139, 146 and 145 to south east corner of said Township thence north along the east line of lots No 144 and 143 being the east line of said Township to the southeast corner of lot No 143 being the south east corner of said Corporate limits as heretofore existing hereby authorizing the Annexation to said existing Corporate limits of the whole of lots No 129, 130, 131, 132, 133, 134, 135, 136, 137, 138, 139, 143, 144, 145, 146 of Tract No 3 of said Township of Chardon

Sec 2^d That W. L. Banfield be and is hereby appointed and directed to prosecute the proceedings now necessary by law to effect such Annexation

Said Corporation respectfully prays your Honorable Board that said described Territory may be duly and legally annexed to and become a part of said Incorporated Village of Chardon and that such proceedings may be had by and before your Honorable Board as are by law required for that purpose

"Notice"

On the 6th of March A.D. 1871 a Petition was presented to the Commissioners of Geauga County Ohio in behalf of the Incorporated Village of Chardon in said County setting forth the desire of said Incorporated Village to enlarge its territorial limits by the annexation of contiguous territory and the passage of an Ordinance by the Council of the Corporation authorizing the annexation to the existing Corporate limits of said Village of the whole of lots No 129, 130, 131, 132, 133, 134, 135, 136, 137, 138, 139, 143, 144, 145, 146 of Tract No 3 of Chardon Township in said County and asking that such proceedings might be had by and before said Commissioners as are required by law to effect such Annexation. It was therefor ordered by said Commissioners that said petition stand for hearing before them at the Auditors Office of said County on the 16th day of May A.D. 1871 at ten o'clock A.M. and that notice thereof be given as provided by law
