

Petition and Proceedings
In relation to the Incorporation of the Village of Burton in the
County of Geauga and State of Ohio.

To the Honorable the Commissioners of Geauga County Ohio.

Your Petitioners the Subscribers hereto respectfully represent. That they are residents of the Township of Burton Geauga County Ohio, and that they are electors in said Town. Second - That they present herewith a map of a territory located near the center of said Township which they desire to have incorporated into a Village of the first class second grade as described by Section 1549 of the Revised Statutes of Ohio. Said map is entitled "A Map of Burton showing the proposed Incorporation limits" and was prepared by E. T. Phelps, County Surveyor. Said territory contains about fourteen hundred & forty acres of land and is divided into One hundred and forty-four (144) lots as shown by said map. being all of the original sixty four lots of the original plat of the Village of Burton and eight additional lots beginning at north west corner of said proposed Incorporation with Lot No. Sixty five (65) and ending at the S. E. corner thereof with lot No One hundred & forty four (144). Said proposed Incorporation is One & One half (1 1/2) miles square. Or three fourths of one mile north-east-south & west from the center. Excepting that the north line thereof shall be the south margin of the road bounding the land of O. G. Notshkus on the north. Said center line is indicated by a stone located in the center of the original plat of the Village of Burton. They further represent that all the subscribers hereto are electors and reside within the proposed Incorporation limits. They further represent that the population now resident within the proposed Incorporation limits is more than Six Hundred and less than three thousand, and is therefore entitled to classification as a Village of the first class, second grade. They further represent that it is their belief that the best interests of the people resident within the above described territory will be served if Incorporation is secured. The name of said Incorporation shall be, The Village of Burton. They hereby name, P. M. Parmelee & G. W. Ford, W. C. Tuttle, W. C. Crittenden & G. W. Wyde, to act as Agents of the Petitioners. They therefore pray you to take the legal steps necessary for the granting of this Petition.
