

Proceedings in relation to the incorporation of Middlefield
Crawford County Ohio - Continued

Middlefield, Ohio, December 1st 1900.

At a special meeting of the Trustees of Middlefield Township, Crawford County, Ohio, held on the above date, a petition was presented to said Trustees, signed by the required number of electors a majority of whom were free holders, praying the said Trustees to submit to the qualified electors residing within the territory in said petition described, and hereafter described, the right to vote upon the question of incorporation, a map of which accompanied said petition, and said Trustees proceeding this day to hear the matter of said petition, and being fully advised in the premises, do find that said territory described in said petition is wholly situated in said Township of Middlefield, that said petition contains all the matters required by law to be contained therein, that its statements are true, that the limits of the proposed corporation are accurately described, that the map accompanying the petition is accurate, that the persons, or at least thirty of them, whose names are subscribed thereto are electors residing on the territory therein described, and that a majority of them are free holders. It was thereupon by said Trustees of Middlefield Township at said meeting, ordered that an election be held for the purpose of determining the sense of the qualified electors upon the question of incorporation as set forth in the said petition. And said Trustees did then at said meeting by further order make and declare that such territory described in said petition, and hereinafter described, should with the assent of the qualified voters thereof, as provided by law, be an incorporated village by the name of the Village of Middlefield, the same being the name specified in said petition, and said Trustees at said meeting did further order and make a notice for the said election by the qualified voters, residents in said territory at the usual places of holding elections therein, to be held on Saturday, December, 15th 1900, for the purpose of determining the sense of the qualified voters in said territory upon the question of incorporation and to determine whether said territory should be incorporated, thereupon said Trustees did duly give ten days notice of such election by publication in the Middlefield Messenger, a newspaper of general circulation in such territory, and caused written notices thereof to be posted in three public places in said territory proposed to be incorporated, a copy of which said notices so published and posted is as follows: -

Notice of an Election.

Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors residing within the following territory, that an Election will be held at the usual voting place on Saturday December 15th A.D. 1900. for determining the sense of the electors upon the question of incorporation. - (Being situated in the Township of Middlefield, County of Crawford, and State of Ohio, and being all of sections Nos. 22, 29 & 32 and parts of sections Nos. 30, 31 & 21 in said township of Middlefield, and bounded and described as follows, to wit: - Beginning at the north-east corner of section No. 22, thence south along the east boundary line of said sections Nos. 22, 29 & 32 to the south east corner of said section No. 32, thence west along the south boundary line of said sections No. 32 & 31, to the south-west corner of land owned by Daniel Shee; thence north along the west boundary line of land owned by said Daniel Shee, R. J. Smith, and J. J. Rose, to the north boundary line of said sections Nos. 21; thence east along the north boundary line of said sections Nos. 21 and 22 to the place of beginning at the north east corner of said section No. 22. Intending hereby to include by this description all of said sections Nos. 22, 29 & 32, and part of said sections Nos. 31, 30 & 21, as herein above described, within the boundaries and limits of said proposed incorporation plat. - A map of the above described territory can be seen at the Township Clerk's Office
