

Proceedings in relation to the incorporation of Middlefield,
Crawford, County Ohio, Continued.

Middlefield, Ohio, Dec. 15th 1900. - At the election held on the above date for the purpose of determining the sense of the qualified electors upon the question of incorporation, the following is the result of said election. Total number of votes cast 142.

Total number of votes cast for incorporation 80
Total number of votes cast against incorporation 62

A majority of all the votes cast, having upon them the words "For Incorporation", the Township Trustees declared and made an order declaring the above described territory to be an incorporated village, and known by the name of The Village of Middlefield. And it is further ordered that a certified transcript, signed by a majority of said Trustees, of all the orders and proceedings of said board in relation to such incorporation, be at once transmitted to the County Records, together with said original petition & map.
